



**Florida PTA Scholarship Award
2017-2018 Application Information**

Eligibility

To be eligible for this scholarship, an applicant must submit the following **postmarked no later than February 1, 2018:**

- _____ completed application reflecting Florida residency
- _____ a copy of your 2017-2018 membership card for your Florida school's PTA/PTSA or the Sunshine State PTSA. Must be a PTA/PTSA member for 30 days (Note: The PTA/PTSA must be in good standing as verified by the scholarship committee.)
- _____ Official Florida high school transcript with your School District seal and (in a separate sealed envelope) Cumulative Summary pages reflecting an unweighted high school grade point average of 3.0 or higher for University and Fine Arts, 2.5 or higher for Community College, and 2.0 or higher for Vo-Tech.
- _____ A copy of an official SAT and/or ACT scores report
- _____ Two (2) letters of reference (one from school and one from community) in a sealed envelope
- _____ Essay (include at the top of the page your name, discuss your goals, field of study, reasons for seeking this scholarship, along with what PTA/PTSA means to you and PTA/PTSA participation. Be sure to include any extenuating circumstances which might contribute to your consideration).

Value of Scholarship

This is a one year (nonrenewable) scholarship for a total of \$2,000.00, which will be sent directly to the school of your choice.

Post Award Requirements

- _____ The awarded recipient must provide proof of registration and enrollment as a full-time undergraduate student in a postsecondary university (public or private), fine arts school, community college or Vo-tech for the 2018-2019 year.
- _____ The awarded recipients must provide proof of their Social Security Number.

Mail the Application packet to Florida PTA State office (address below) postmarked no later than February 1, 2018.

If applying for multiple scholarships, each application must be clearly marked and separated within the same envelope.

Date of Notification

The scholarship recipients will be notified by US mail and/or e-mail by May 1, 2018. Scholarship winners will have until July 1, 2018 to accept the award. After July 1, 2018 the scholarship will be revoked.
