Applications will be accepted January 1st – April 1st (or until funds have been exhausted). All applications must be submitted electronically on the form below. Applications will be reviewed as received. Any incomplete applications will not be reviewed. Funding is limited, and therefore, competitive. One award per PTA/PTSA organization. All funds must be used by May 16, 2015.

All applications submitted must adhere to the mission and purposes of PTA and must be for an educational or advocacy related project.

Mission - To help children build a foundation for success by engaging and empowering families and communities to advocate for all children.

Historical Purposes of PTA - To promote the welfare of children and youth in home, school, community, and place of worship; to raise the standards of home life; to secure adequate laws for the care and protection of children and youth; to bring into closer relation the home and the school, so that parents and teachers may cooperate intelligently in the education of children and youth; to develop united efforts between educators and the general public such as will secure for all children and youth the highest advantages in physical, mental, social, and spiritual education.
