This year the Pinellas County School District is providing free tutoring services for eligible students through Supplemental Educational Services. If your child scored a Level 1 or Level 2 on FCAT, he/she is eligible to receive tutoring services. The exciting news is that you have an opportunity to **select** Pinellas County School District as your child's provider.

Why should you select Pinellas?

- Your child will be tutored by a certified/highly qualified teacher.
- Your child can receive tutoring service at the school he/she attends.
- The instructional strategies and interventions used to support your child's progress will be similar to the strategies used in your child's classroom.
- Family resources will be provided to support the learning environment at home
- Your child SLP will be carefully monitored by SES staff as well as the teacher
- Provide enrichment activities and incentives for student who are performing well
